- **Age verification (original documents only):** Birth certificate, passport, I-94, a transcript or report card from a California school.

New and returning students (Current students who have moved must present address verification as well.)

- **Grade level verification (grades 2-12):** Most recent report card (grades 2-8). Transcript (grades 9-12).
- **Verification of residence (3 original documents with the parent's, guardian's, or caregiver's name and address on it):** Driver's license or official California ID Card from the Department of Motor Vehicles, **AND** a utility bill dated within 90 days (PG&E, home telephone bill, water bill, garbage bill, or cable bill), automobile registration, automobile insurance, homeowner's/renter's insurance policy, property tax statement, or official letter from a social services/government agency within 90 days.
- **Transitional families:** Transitional families ~~reside at a non-permanent address~~, such as a motel/hotel, shelter, car, or are doubled up with relatives or friends due to hardship. Transitional families unable to establish a permanent residence can go to the Transitional Students and Families Program in Portable 15 at 1025 Second Avenue for residency verification and assistance. OTHER NOTICES

Students may not be assigned to any of the schools selected due to limited space availability. The District does not provide transportation within or outside of a student's attendance area unless a student is being required to attend a non-neighborhood despite his/her desire to attend a neighborhood school. Families applying by the initial due date will be notified of their student's assignment via mail by March 15, 2007. To retain a child's placement, the parent/guardian must register the student at his/her assigned school. Whether or not a student is assigned to a selected school, in general, the school assignment will be final and may not be changed until the following academic year (2007-2008). Special Day Class students will be placed by the Programs for Exceptional Children. Finally, if a student is not promoted to the next grade level, the student's school placement can change.
